Spiritual Investing Values

For all their differences, Christianity, Judaism and Islam share many beliefs on at least one subject: the management of money. In all three religions, those who seek to apply their spiritual values to personal investing will find scriptural guidance. Common among the faiths is a conviction that the money a person has ... no matter how little or how much ... comes from God, and that individuals must be good stewards of what's been given to them. When you get to the Pearly Gates, the Lord isn't going to say, "What rate of return did you get?" God is going to ask, "What did you do with what I have given you?" God intends each person to be a prudent money manager. The idea of stewardship means that you need to be careful and responsible with the use of your money. That encourages people to budget and to live within their means and not to be so focused on materialism that they lose sight of the higher values in life. People must understand that their financial resources don't really belong to them. Part of it is to manage money in a way that acknowledges that God is the owner. A steward is one who's in charge of managing the possessions of another in the best interest of the owners. The other person is God. I'm just managing what God has entrusted to me, but I'm doing it in his best interest.
